Below is a quick guide to the administrative and program committees and the contact person(s) for each area. If you want to know more detail about any of these committees you'll find it in The United Methodist Book of Discipline of which I have a copy in my office. A contact person(s) is listed for each committee or team, but you can always contact Rev. Brock for information about any of the duties and responsibilities for any of the groups or committees or programs of the church.

The church council provides for the planning and implementation of church programs and ministries. It sets the vision, mission, and goals for the church. It sets and administers the

annual budget. Randy Greene is the chair of our church council. He is the one to call if you have any questions about overall church governance or would like to be on the agenda. Meetings are generally scheduled for the last Monday of each month, if needed. The Book of Discipline states they have to meet quarterly.

The finance committee is in charge of stewardship and for developing and implementing plans to raise sufficient funds to meet the budgetary needs of the church. It is also charged with developing an annual budget to submit to the church council. Tim Smock is the chair and all questions should be directed to him.

The staff/parish relations committee (SPR) is the liaison between the church and staff. It is responsible for determining the paid staff that is necessary to operate the church and its programs and ministries. It determines salaries for each paid position. Works in cooperation with the pastor in evaluating staff. Annually in consultation with the pastor determines the pastoral needs of the church. This is the only committee that has closed meetings. Beth Kein is the chair of SPR, but you may contact any member of SPR if you have any questions or comments about the pastor or staff.

The trustees are responsible for building and grounds operations, maintenance, and upkeep. This includes recommendations to church council for replacement and capital improvements. The trustees, at the behest of the charge conference, are responsible for the sale, purchase, mortgage, or construction of any real property or assets of the church. They are charged with protecting the assets of the church. They are also charged with accepting or rejecting any gifts or bequests to the church. Mark Joiner is the chair of trustees but you may contact any of the members of trustees if you have any questions or suggestions.

Paula Pharr is the lay leader for 2019. The lay leader's primary responsibilities are to: work in conjunction with the pastor to enlist, prepare, train, and empower laity to become active in the ministries and programs of the church; and to encourage and foster the laity's role in the church and her programs and ministries. Paula is the one to contact if you have a question about any of the ministries or programs of the church or if you want to know how to get plugged in somewhere.

Charlotte Land is the lay member to annual conference (LMTAC). The LMTAC attends the annual conference and reports on the actions of the annual conference to the church.

Paula Pharr is the church council secretary. She records and keeps the minutes of the meetings.

Roy Townsend is the church council treasurer. The treasurer disburses all money contributed to causes represented in the local church budget, and such other funds and contributions at the direction of the church council.

Joyce Marks represents the Expressing Faith teams to church council. These are the teams and groups that are involved with worship and worship activities.

Martha Greene represents the Growing Faith teams to church council. These are the educational and fellowship groups and programs including Sunday School, small groups, children's and youth ministries, UMW, Nightingals, UMM, Bible studies, hospitality, etc.
